A fantasy contains at least one fantastic or unreal element. They are often based on myths and legends, and may have a fantastic element such as elves, fairies, or talking plants.

In contrast, science fiction uses the imagination as well, but it usually takes place in the future or in outer space, and the imaginary objects are based on real or possible science and technology.
